APPROVAL OF MINUTES

MOTION

It was moved by Committee Member Rosa Gomez, seconded by Committee Member Shirley Harry and carried on a unanimous vote that the General Plan Steering Committee approve the minutes of October 28, 2015.

II. PUBLIC COMMENT

Members of the public made the following comments:

- Police Department needs help, they need one central office to meet and not run around
- The public should have more involvement, need dialog with the Committee, not just speak and vote
- Troy Clark was thanked for his involvement in meeting with stakeholder groups. Would like to see safety included in the General Plan
- Concern expressed over high density housing. Adopt what is best for the City
- Definition of Vision is not concise and points in the wrong direction.

III. REVISED DRAFT OF GENERAL PLAN THEMES

- Many of the ideas are the same from twenty years ago, themes are comprehensive and supportive
- Definition of wording being requested; example: sustainability
- Emergency Operations seems to be out of place
- Land Use needs to be addressed
- Members of the Committee made several recommendation for additions and changes to the matrix

PUBLIC COMMENT

Members of the public made the following comments on the themes:

- What format is being used for the General Plan, the current guidelines or the proposed under development?
- The Vision definition is not concise as stated
- Matrix is an environmentalist's dream
- Emergency Management and Public Safety should move up in the priority

MOTION

It was moved by Committee Member Jon Harrison, second by Committee Member Ken Jeske and approved unanimously to adopt the *preliminary* draft of the Themes with the recommended changes from the Committee

MOTION

It was moved by Committee Jon Harrison, second by Committee Member Jeske and approved unanimously to provide definitions of the themes in the General Plan language.
