MINUTES

1. Traffic and Parking Commission - Call to Order, Roll Call, and Approval of Minutes

Commissioners present: Luis Estrada, Paul Letson, Emily Elliott, Robert Duron, Anna Jaiswal, Edward Mandolang, Curtis Dison.

Minutes of the Regular Meeting of March 26, 2015 – Anna Jaiswal made a motion to approve. Robert Duron seconded. Minutes were approved.

2. Correspondence and Communications – None

3. Old Business

A. Request to Remove an Existing Loading Zone on Center Street at McKinley Elementary School.

Emily Elliott made a motion to recommend to City Council approval of the request to remove an existing loading zone on Center Street at McKinley Elementary School. Paul Letson seconded. Commission asked about the estimated timeline for removing the loading zone. Staff replied that the priority is low but the work can be done quickly. Motion carried unanimously

4. New Business

A. Request to Install Two Additional Stop Signs to Achieve a Four-Way Stop Intersection at Citrus Avenue and Iowa Street.

Anna Jaiswal made a motion to recommend to City Council approval of the request to install two additional stop signs to achieve a four-way stop intersection at Citrus Avenue and Iowa Street. Curtis Dison seconded. Paul Letson raised concern about the backlog of approved commission items. The intersection of Eureka Street and Olive Avenue is supposed to have stop signs. Staff will look into this signage to verify its' approval. Approved items will be installed chronologically. Motion carried unanimously.

5. Public Discussion and Comment

Alphonso Vijil came to represent 420 and 430 East Fern Avenue, which are next to the Fern Lodge. He addressed the Commission about visitors to Fern Lodge who park on the street for days in front of his house. This has been occurring for 2 to 3 years. He requested a 2-hour parking time limit, which the Commission mentioned acknowledged was unusual for residential neighborhoods. Neighborhood issues are “delicate”. Staff will conduct some fact-finding including the zoning of Fern Lodge and any parking requirements they have. Also look into parking restrictions for the side streets off Brookside Avenue and near Beaver Medical Clinic.
