NOTICE is hereby given that the City Council of the City of Redlands, County of San Bernardino, State of California, will hold a public hearing to consider the following:

1. **PUBLIC HEARING** to consider **Resolution No. 8571** adopting the Development Impact Fee Nexus Study, **Ordinance No. 2962 and Ordinance No. 2968** amending Chapters 3.32, 3.44, 3.48, 3.54, 3.56, 3.60, 3.70, and 13.40 of the Redlands Municipal Code (RMC), and adopting the Development Impact Fees, respectively. Public Hearing to consider the adoption of the resolution and ordinances is exempt pursuant to Section 15301 of the California Environmental Quality Act Guidelines. The proposed revisions to Chapters 3.32, 3.44, 3.48, 3.54, 3.56, 3.60, 3.70, and 13.40 include the following: amend various RMC sections to include updated Development Impact Fees.
