Required Information for Permit Issuance

- 1. San Bernardino Department of Environmental Health Services permit for Program #2706 Liquid Waste Hauling/Disposal for each vehicle registered.
- 2. Proof of Insurance naming City of Redlands as Additional Insured (see attached).
- 3. Current business license with the City of Redlands (see attached).
- 4. W-9 Form (see attached).
- 5. Applicable permit fees (see below).

Fee Information

- 1. A fee at the rate of \$0.11/gallon will be charged based on the capacity of the tank of the Liquid Waste Hauler, with a minimum fee of \$16.20.
- 2. A permit fee of \$100 will be charged for each Liquid Waste Hauling vehicle
- 3. Payment is to be submitted in the form of a check or money order made payable to the City of Redlands.
- 4. Fees are subject to change.

Important Information

- 1. All Liquid Waste Hauling Vehicles must be registered on the Permit Application.
- 2. The Liquid Waste Hauler Discharge Permit is non-transferable.
- 3. Drivers must fill out the Sewage Dumping Receipt completely before discharging.
- 4. Drivers are responsible for cleaning up their own spills.
- 5. Drivers are not to leave their vehicle unattended during the discharge process.
- 6. Failure to comply with the rules of the wastewater treatment plant may result in the suspension of discharging privileges.
